A novice rider or novice horse is one that has not received more than five (5) first place awards (other than halter) from any associaton prior to January 1 of the current year.

A beginner is a rider with limited experience riding and/or showing

MEMBERS:

1. To be eligible for a year-end award, each horse/rider must have competed in that approved class in at least 60% of the shows held during the 2022 season,

AND

2. In order to qualify for year-end awards, each horse/rider must show at a PHA Benefit Show, OR make a minimum sponsorship of \$50 to a PHA Benefit Show OR work at a benefit show (work can be performed by a family member or designee)
